

Dear Residents:

As always, we hope you and your families are doing well, and more importantly keeping safe and healthy

Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to put pressure and restrictions on our daily lives.

This is a reminder that we need to remain vigilant with the policies and protocols already implemented at 50 Quebec, such as wearing a mask in all common areas, keeping 2 meters physical distance from each other, a maximum of 2 persons per elevator at a time, sanitizing and/or washing your hands frequently, and limiting non-essential visits.

ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS IMPLEMENTED

A new mandatory daily worker screening process has been implemented for on site staff and any essential trades working in the building. If you do have a contractor coming to your suite, please have them sign in with the management office everyday. Forms are available at the door of the management office and can be dropped off at the mail slot of the door when the office is closed.

A Government Canada standardized screening form is attached.

PRIVACY IF A MEMBER OF OUR COMMUNITY BECOMES INFECTED

If you become ill and/or are presenting symptoms associated to COVID-19, please immediately contact your health care provider or Toronto Public Health at 416-338-7600 for care and advice.

Residents who suspect they may be infected, exhibit symptoms or have been diagnosed with COVID-19 are requested to self-isolate and not use the common elements of the building and contact the Management right away so extra disinfecting measures can be taken.

Should a member of the staff become infected, every effort will be made to provide a relief worker to cover during the staff member's absence.

If Management is informed that a member of our community is diagnosed with COVID-19, general notices will be posted to alert the community of the requirement for heightened precautions. However, please be aware that in keeping with privacy regulations, the specific identity or location of infected members will not be divulged.

PARCELS

The number of parcels in and around the building has increased and as you all have noticed a parcel shelving unit is taking shape in the lobby. This work should be

completed next week. If you do expect a parcel please do come by and check frequently. The staff is labeling the parcels for an easier identification.
