

YCC 323 UPDATE COVID-19 August 4th, 2020

Dear Residents,

As Toronto has officially entered the stage 3 of the reopening it is important to understand that the provincial easing of restrictions is driven primarily by a requirement to kick- start the economy. The decisions to open any of the indoor amenities is a decision that is not taken lightly and is still being evaluated and will be driven by health and safety considerations rather than economic considerations. 50 Quebec and its residents have been keeping well and staying safe and we would like nothing more than to keep the community safe moving forward.

At this time the Gym, sauna, games room along with the meeting room will remain closed until a safe reopening plan can be presented to residents, this will include cleaning protocols, sign in sheets, limited capacity and protocols assuring all residents can safely practice social distancing when in any areas of the premises. Amenities will be open in stages and will be communicated to residents once a decision is made.

As masks are required in all common areas which include all hallways, stairwells, elevators, lobby, lockers and the underground garage it is imperative to communicate this to all family members, friends and delivery persons to always keep a face covering when moving through the building.

Please note the Donation bin has restarted its collection and is available to all residents, in addition to the recycling room there is a battery collection box and a bulb collecting basket for your convenience.

Please be advised that the board of Directors of YCC 323 has adopted a Policy to wear mandatory face coverings/masks in all common areas of the building. Please inform your visitors, contractors, deliveries to comply with this policy and wear face coverings when entering 50 Quebec Ave and moving through its common areas.
