## YCC 323/COVID-19 Update March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022

## Dear Residents,

Ontario continues to ease public health measures as the number of infections and numbers of hospitalizations are on the decrease. The impact of the lifting of measures on 50 Quebec is set out below:

Although capacity limits have been removed, public health continues to require social distancing measures be in place. Capacity limits in our indoor facilities remain to ensure that users have enough space to maintain a 2-meter physical distance from those outside their household.

Elevator capacity of two will remain with flexibility to those who are asked and feel comfortable with there being an additional person joining.

Daily screening of staff and contractors is no longer required. However, we must facilitate/encourage passive screening. Signs are posted at all entrances informing individuals how to screen themselves for COVID-19 prior to entering. The posters will include a QR code which will direct the visitor to the self-screening tool on their phone and at the end of the questionnaire there will be an option to send the screening to an email or save a copy. The use of this tool is encouraged for residents, contractors, and visitors as well. Paper copies will also remain for now for those who would prefer completing a paper screening.

Residents and visitors must continue to wear masks in all indoor communal areas of the building (subject to usual medical exemptions). This is not only a provincial policy but a policy of 50 Quebec.

Most legal advice recommends that condominium communities continue to maintain restrictions that are stricter than those required by the provincial regulations for the near future.

The unique risks and desires of residents will have to be careful balanced out as restrictions ease further. All decisions are carefully thought out and considered by the board of directors with health and safety of the residents in mind.
