The High Park Movement Strategy was launched in 2021 to rethink the travel network serving High Park. The goal is to improve mobility within the park, while prioritizing safety, accessibility and the park's ecological integrity.

Beginning on Saturday August 5, there will be a number of improvements to the travel network in High Park, including:

- •West Road and portions of Colborne Lodge Drive will be car-free routes at all times
- •Car-free weekends and holidays will continue
- Parking spaces will be reduced. Pick-up and drop-off spaces will be provided at key destinations
- •Improvements will be made to pedestrian crosswalks
- •Bike lanes will be added on Colborne Lodge Drive and Centre Road
- Visitor vehicles will not be permitted to enter at Bloor Street West
